## Safety Procedures at 2022 Canadian Biathlon Championships

This event falls under the Biathlon Canada Mandatory Vaccination Policy.

**Athletes, Coaches, Support Staff:** All participants entering the field of play must be vaccinated. We will be checking for proof of vaccination at accreditation and after that point your accreditation will be considered proof of vaccination. No participants will be allowed to enter the field of play prior to going through accreditation. Please allow time for this and plan on it being done in person rather than by a proxy.

**Volunteers, Officials, Media:** All volunteers and officials will be required to check in daily to the volunteer office. Proof of vaccination will be checked prior to volunteer badges being given out. To get onto the field of play all volunteers, officials and media must show their volunteer badge or accreditation. Please allow enough time in the mornings to do this check in.

Masks are mandatory in all indoor settings during the event except when eating. When on the field of play (outdoors) all participants are encouraged to maintain social distancing and/or where a mask. Hand sanitizing stations will be located throughout the venue.

**Spectators:** Spectators will not be entering the field of play. When in the spectator area they are encouraged to maintain social distance or wear a mask. Spectators will not be required to show proof of vaccination.

**Out and About Around Prince George:** As per Provincial Health Orders, masks are required when visiting retail and service locations. Restaurants are required to ask for proof of vaccination. Please note: if your provincial credentials are no longer in effect the federal passport is an excellent proof of vaccination.
